Our students become productive citizens and future leaders through the value of service that is instilled in them by their parents and all those who guide them through their Catholic education journey.

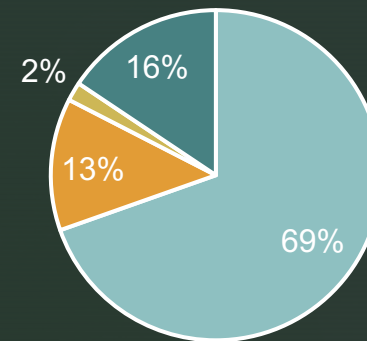
2021-2022 Financial Snapshot

Elementary School Revenue \$30,246,483



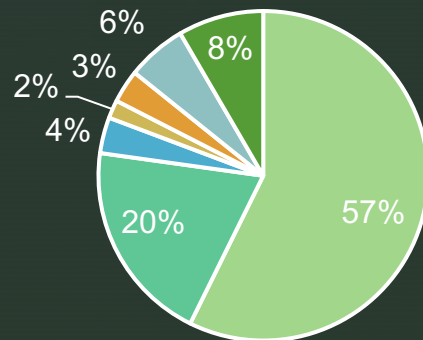

High School Revenue \$25,142,393



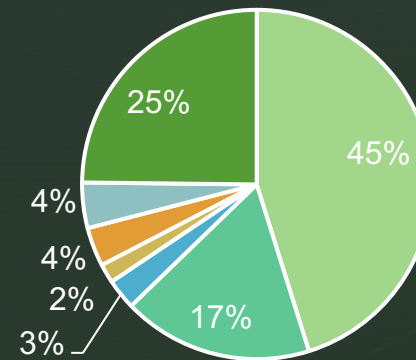
